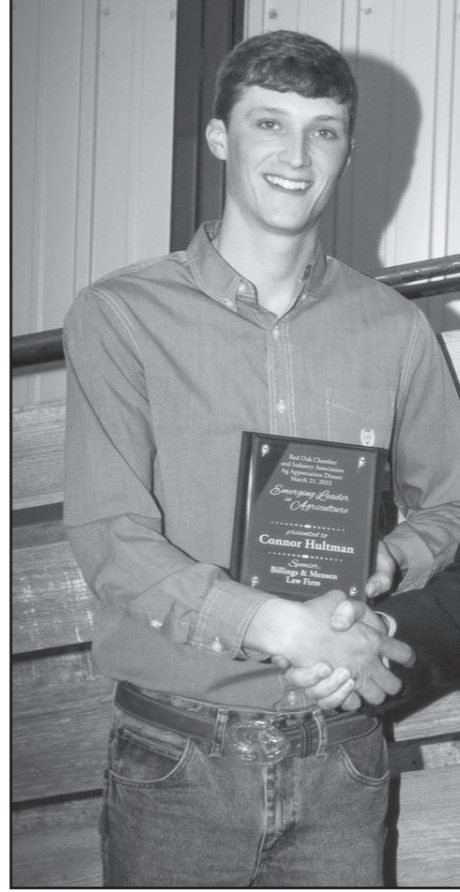
5th Annual Ag Appreciation Dinner
